# **INSTALLATION**

- 1. Place batteries.
- a). Open the battery cover under the keyboard and place 2 AAA batteries inside.



b). Close the battery compartment cover.

4. a. Power the keyboard by switching it "**ON**". The power switch is located on the left edge of the keyboard's backside. (By default the power of the keyboard is switched "**ON**".)

b. Press the "CONNECT" button for 1 second then release.

# NOTE:

- RF Signal LED on the receiver will flash when the keyboard is being used.
- When the Battery Low LED is ON, it means the keyboard requires to change the batteries.
- The keyboard goes to sleep mode after 5 mins of inactivity but we suggest to turn "**OFF**" the keyboard when leaving your desk for more than an hour to save battery life for longer lasting use.





c. Connection will be successful once the LED light of the receiver will stop blinking.

To help maximize the battery life of your keyboard, the Green LED of the Caps Lock and Number Lock key will only stay on for approximately 30 seconds while the keyboard is idle. However, the Caps Lock and Number Lock keys will still be engaged, even though the LED is off. When you being typing, the LED will light again.

#### TROUBLESHOOTING

If you cannot get your keyboard to work after installation, please try the following:

1. Make sure you have connected the receiver correctly to the computer. The receiver has been properly plugged onto computer's USB ports.

2. Make sure you have inserted two AAA batteries inside the battery compartment correctly. Move the keyboard closer to the receiver.

3. Wireless phone, routers and other devices that uses 2.4GHz frequency, might cause interference with your keyboard.
